The Challenges:

- re-design a book jacket
- bake a cake or create a piece of art to represent your favourite character from the book
- write a haiku about how the book makes you feel. A haiku is a poem which has 3 lines (1st line has 5 syllables, 2nd line has 7 syllables, 3rd line has 5 syllables)
- make a 60 second video to encourage people to read the book you have enjoyed
